Master's degree courses are offered in media psychology, sport psychology/psychological counselling, business psychology with focus on human resource and organization development, business administration.

For their international business administration program - which includes one compulsory term abroad and two international project studies (internships) – BSP is seeking a partner university in Taiwan.

Prof. Shen Cen-Chu, director of the education division, visited BSP and was received by the president, the head of the international office and the dean of the program. Prof. Shen introduced Tunghai University to BSP. They are equally looking for partners in Germany for their international business administration program. Soon after Prof. Shen's visit the two universities got into contact and exchanged first ideas and possibilities of future collaboration. It looks like a very promising new alliance.
